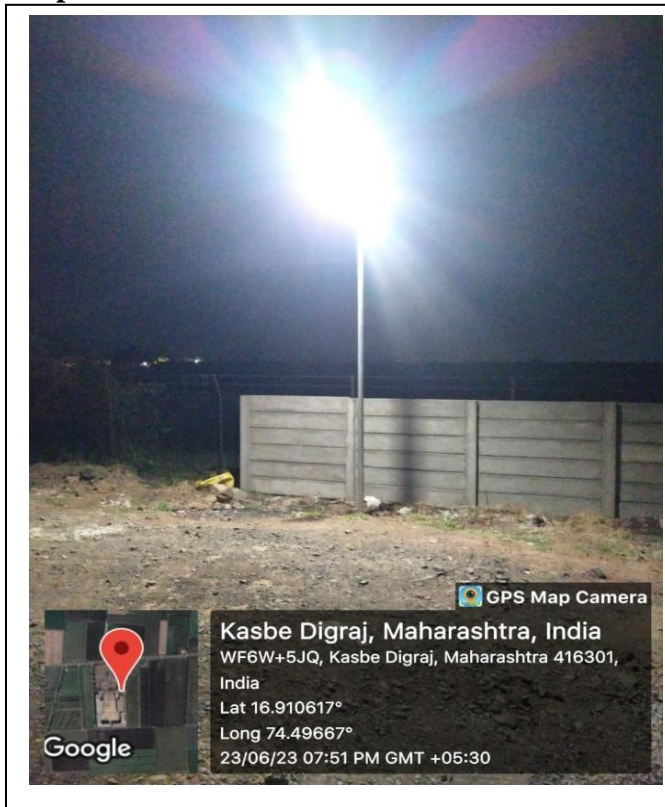
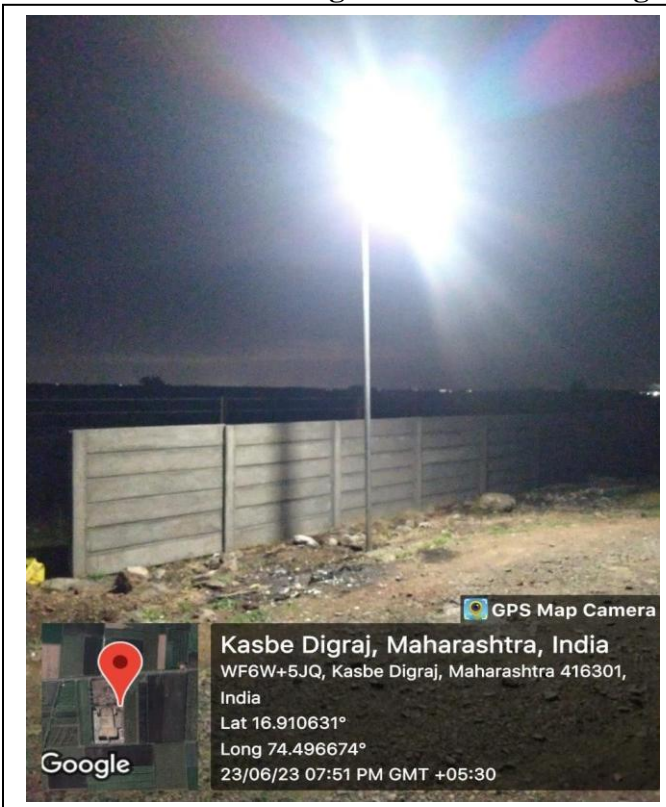

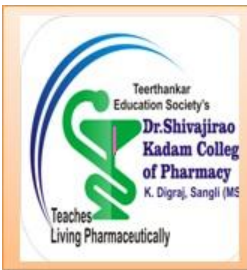

➤ **Present status of college.**

Dr. Shivajirao Kadam College Of Pharmacy was established in 2016, it mainly has two courses viz. D.Pharm and B.Pharm.

There are 12 classrooms, 6 cabins, 1 library, 3 laboratories, 1 girls common room and 1 auditorium classroom.

The purpose is to identify, quantify, describe and prioritize framework of environmental sustainability in compliance with the applicable regulations, policies and standards. - To introduce and make students aware of real concerns of environment and its sustainability.

- To secure the environment and cut down the threats posed to human health by analyzing the pattern and extent of resource use on the campus.
- To bring out a status report on environmental compliance.

➤ **Assessment Methodology.**

- In order to collect factual data the assessment team has interacted with concerned management personnel and visited different areas of the institution namely common classrooms, utility area, office, staff rooms, library, electric room (meter room), overheadwater storage, toilets kitchen and canteen, waste storage area, drainage system landscape ground, green house and parking, to ensure comprehensive coverage the assessment has been categorized into broad modules to facilitate a structured evaluation. The modules are as follows:

Waste management	Tree Plantation Management
Energy Conservation	Transportation Management
Water Management	Green and Biodiversity Management

- The assessment observations are supported by few photographs which have been captured during the visit.

➤ **Waste Management:**

Observation:

- The waste generated are mainly papers wastes, garbage, and few amount of medical waste from the labs.
- There are 3 bins provided in each floor of building, and separate bins are provided in each classroom and laboratory, but there are no separate bins for general dry garbage and wet garbage.

- Reusing single-sided waste paper as notepads, creating a separate tray in the printing for single-sides used waste paper.
- Cardboard box are reused where possible.
- Disposable paper cups and glass cups are provided for the tea and coffee for all.
- The wet garbage from Canteen, tree leaves are used efficiently for compost.
- Compost is rich in nutrients. It is used for trees and shrubs in the campus.
- For waste water coming from toilets and washrooms they had adopted soak pit method for waste water management.
- The waste is dumped into the trench.



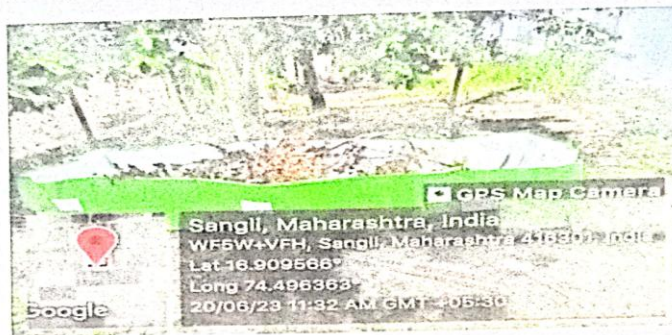
Recommendation:

- Need to separate bins for wastes which helps to segregate wastes easily.
- More awareness programs should be conducted by college for students, college staff about waste management.
- Proper storage and safer disposal of waste, efficient and proper waste treatment, effective waste conservation and increasing resource recovery from waste should be done adequately.
- Need to adopt vermin composting method for waste management.
- Plastic free zones should be declared by the administration .

➤ **Energy Management:**

Observation:

- About 30 Florescent tubes are installed in classroom, and offices which are being replaced by LEDs with a week, whereas other 75 Led tubes are already installed.
- Utilization of natural light when possible and electricity is appropriately used (avoiding its misuse).
- The planning of classrooms and offices is done such that there is adequet amount of light from the windows during the day time thus saving the energy.
- Shady trees are placed surrounding of the college and school.
- The college has trees and a plants, that the environment carbon dioxide frees and to maintain health of all the inmates.
- The campus has, palm trees, coconut, peepal trees, and other trees, which provide shade and beautiful ambience. And also shrubs provided along the pathway.
- Some classrooms have a lack of natural light and ventilation.
- For each classroom fans are provided. About 101 fans are installed throughout.

Recommendations:

- High energy consuming incandescent lights and fluorescent lights in classrooms have to be replaced by less energy consuming LED lights.
- The college can introduce solar panel to reduce carbon foot print.

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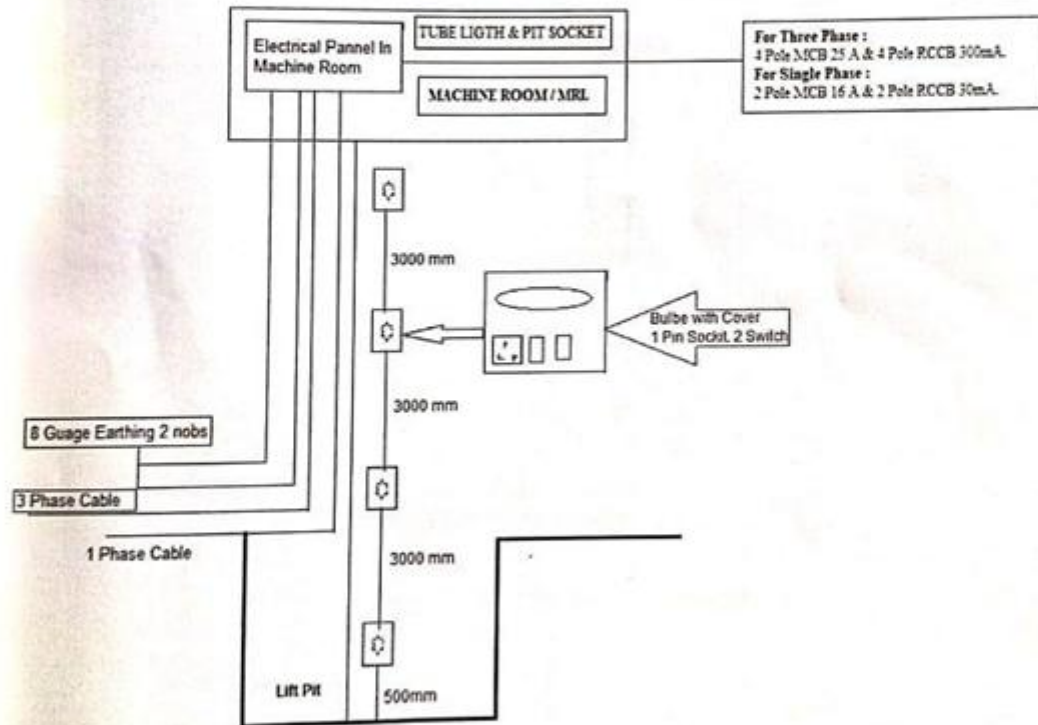
