Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)

Every year, SKCP College conducts a Student Satisfaction Survey to gather feedback on the students' perception of Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, aiming to enhance the quality of processes in our institution. All students of the class are encouraged to participate in the survey, ensuring that every student has an opportunity to provide their valuable insights. In SSS there would be twenty one questions all over and out of which, twenty questions would be objective type and one question provides opportunity for the students to give their observations/suggestions in a descriptive way to improve the overall teaching-learning experience at Dr. Shivajirao Kadam College of pharmacy.

The questionnaire encompasses a comprehensive range of categories, covering various aspects from facilities to teaching-learning and evaluation. Additionally, it evaluates the overall approach to education, such as motivation, interpersonal relationships, feedback, and adaptability of teaching methods to cater to weaker students. The questionnaire utilizes a Likert scale with graded marking, allowing students to rate their responses on a scale of 0 to 4. Highest positive response is rated as 4 and the lowest negative response is rated as 0. This approach provides a more nuanced and comfortable range for students to express their opinions, eliminating the binary forced approach.

Each student is provided with Vmedlife login details to access and submit their responses. Approximately 336 students are encouraged to participate in the survey. The questionnaire is hosted on the Vmedulite portal under the online survey section.

A total of 336 students responded to the survey, and the feedback provided was analyzed to evaluate the performance of stakeholders.

The analysis of the survey is conducted on the vmedulife portal, utilizing its robust mechanism. The portal aggregates the responses and generates a score for the student satisfaction survey. The portal follows a comprehensive and unambiguous approach to quantifying the student feedback, ensuring a holistic assessment.

The feedback is thoroughly analyzed by the appellate authorities, who draw inferences from it and implement necessary corrective measures.




